• **Kelaniya Raja Maha Viharaya** – It is believed that the Lord Buddha visited this temple and preached to his followers, seated on a jeweled chair.

## **Day Excursion to Kandy**



Kandy, affectionately referred to as the Hill Capital of the island, was the last stronghold of the Sinhala Kings. The city still retains much of its ancient grandeur from time immemorial. Therefore it comes as no surprise that the entire city is a UNESCO World Heritage Site. The city is encircled by hills and a tranquil lake sits in the middle of the city. The island's most visited temple – The Temple of the Tooth – serenely sits by the banks of the lake. This temple enshrines the Sacred Tooth Relic of the Lord Buddha. The highlight of the city's calendar is the Esala Perahera, when a replica of the tooth is paraded along the streets of Kandy. This procession is believed to be Asia's most majestic parade.

Kandy affectionately referred to as the Hill Capital of the island, was Pinnawela Elephant Orphanage – set amongst the verdant hills of Kegalle is a unique orphanage, where tiny tots weigh over 60kgs! Pinnawela Elephant Orphanage is the world's first elephant orphanage established to feed, nurse and house young elephants who are lost or abandoned by their mothers. Elephants that have been displaced due to development projects and wounded elephants have also found refuge at the orphanage. Key highlights during your visit will should include the baby elephants being fed from gigantic feeding bottles or bathed in the river which flows nearby – an unforgettable sight!
